RACING RULES OF SAILING WORKSHOP 2021 – 2024 MODULE 6- Part 2 section C – AT MARKS AND OBSTRUCTIONS RRS 18.1 – WHEN RULE 18 APPLIES


- 1. In the last module we covered RRS 17 –ON SAME TACK PROPER COURSE. This rule is the last rule in Part 2 Section B General Limitations.
- 2. Revision of Module 5: Rule 17 Key Points are:
 - a. Overlap must be established from clear astern, closer than 2 boat lengths.
 - b. Overlap must be established to leeward with boats on the same tack.
 - c. Leeward boat must not sail above her *proper course* while these circumstances remain unchanged.
 - d. R 17 does not apply if the *overlap* begins while the *windward* boat is required by R 13 to *keep clear*.
 - e. The starting signal must have been made (R17 does not apply before the starting signal as there is no proper course before the start.)

Part 2 section C – AT MARKS AND OBSTRUCTIONS RRS 18.1 – WHEN RULE 18 APPLIES

- 3. **OBJECTIVE:** At the end of this module, you will be able to:
 - Identify circumstances when R 18 applies.
 - b. Identify situations where R18 does not apply.
 - b. State the distance of a zone for RC racing. and
 - State the definition of mark-room.
- 4. In the definition *Zone*, the distance for radio sailing is changed from three to four hull lengths of the boat nearest the zone by E 1.1:

Zone The area around a *mark* within a distance of **four** hull lengths of the boat nearer to it. A boat is in the *zone* when any part of her hull is in the *zone*





SECTION C

AT MARKS AND OBSTRUCTIONS

Section C rules do not apply at a starting mark surrounded by navigable water or at its anchor line from the time boats are approaching them to start until they have passed them

- 5. Rule 18 contains the following four sections:
 - a. 18.1 describes when R 18 applies and when it does not apply.
 - b. 18.2 covers giving mark-room.
 - c. 18.3 covers when a boat passes head to wind (tacks) within the zone. and
 - d. 18.4 covers gybing within the zone.
- 6. Rule 18 key points are:
 - a. No part of rule 18 applies at a start line surrounded by navigable waters.
 - b. When no rule of Section C applies to a boat at a mark, the rules of section A. B will apply.
 - c. Rule 18 does not apply to boats on different tacks on a beat to windward.
 - d. Mark is to be rounded on the same side.
 - e. The rules of R 18 do not change the ROW, only rules 10, 11, 12, and 13 do that. Under specific circumstances, R 18 may grant mark-room which may limit the ROW boat's ability to sail as she pleases. and
 - f. R18 no longer applies when mark-room has been given.
- 7. Rule 18.1, When Rule 18 applies, states:

18 MARK-ROOM

18.1 When Rule 18 Applies

Rule 18 applies between boats when they are required to leave a *mark* on the same side and at least one of them is in the *zone*. However, it does not apply

- (a) between boats on opposite tacks on a beat to windward,
- (b) between boats on opposite *tacks* when the *proper course* at the *mark* for one but not both of them is to tack,
- (c) between a boat approaching a *mark* and one leaving it, or if the *mark* is a continuing *obstruction*, in which case rule 19 applies.

Rule 18 no longer applies between boats when mark-room has been given.



8. The RRS definition defines *mark-room* as:

Mark-Room Room for a boat to leave a mark on the required side. Also,

- (a) room to sail to the mark when her proper course is to sail close to it, and
- (b) room to round or pass the mark as necessary to sail the course without touching the mark.

However, *mark-room* for a boat does not include *room* to tack unless she is *overlapped* inside and to *windward* of the boat required to give *mark-room* and she would be *fetching* the *mark* after her tack.






TEST OF OBJECTIVES RRS 18 – WHEN RULE 18 APPLIES.

In the following questions, you are only asking to identify (Yes/No, and state reasons for your answer) if a rule of 18 is in force at the position indicated. You are not required at this stage to identify which boat has the right-of-way, or which boat has *mark-room*.







10. In diagram 9, does rule 18 apply at position1?

ANSWERS:

- 1. No. The boats are on opposite tacks on a beat to windward.
- 2. Yes. Boats are overlapped, on the same tack, and required to pass the mark on the same side when blue enters the zone.
- 3. No. R 18 does not apply at a starting line surrounded by navigable waters.
- 4. Yes. Boats are overlapped, on the same tack, and required to pass the mark on the same side when red enters the zone.
- 5. Yes. They are leaving the mark on the same side and are within the zone.
- 6. No. The boats are on opposite tacks on a beat to windward.
- 7. No. R 18 does not apply between a boat approaching and one leaving a mark.
- 8. Yes. They are required to leave the mark on the same side and at least one of them are within the zone.
- 9. Yes. They are required to leave the mark on the same side and at least one of them are within the zone.
- 10. No. Neither boat is within the zone.
